Responsibilities include graduate and undergraduate teaching (BHS, MHS, PhD levels), programmatic research, and research mentorship (including serving on and chairing MHS and PhD thesis/dissertation committees). Candidates must have a doctoral degree in Speech, Language and Hearing Sciences or a related discipline.
